Career decisions refer to choices that you make about occupations, education, training and employment throughout life. During your school years you will make a number of career decisions.

Decisions about education and training include choosing:

- School subjects.
- Type of curriculum, e.g., VET, academic.
- Post-school education or training courses.
- Type of preparation for an occupation, e.g., apprenticeship, traineeship, TAFE, university.

These education and training choices can influence the range of options available to you in your early career after finishing school.

Decisions about occupations include:

- Deciding on a preferred career field that includes a group of related occupations.
- Deciding on a specific occupation.
