


## Reviewing Career Goals and Plans

- Achieving a higher ATAR than expected, opening up a broader range of post-school course options.
- The emergence of a new occupation as a result of new technology.
- An unexpected offer of a traineeship in an occupation you had not previously considered.
- Limited apprenticeships in your preferred occupation in your local region when you are looking for one.
- A major local industry shedding jobs in your preferred occupation.
